
Please check your emails for a code from PhotoLife. If you did not receive an email from PhotoLife, you can ask at the office for the code.

### Our major focus points in 2025

Attendance, Structured Literacy & Structured Maths will be the main focus points next year. Just to give you a heads up we will be focusing more on Structured Literacy and then slowly introduce Structured Maths. I do not want to overwhelm our teachers with the new Literacy and Maths programmes, so we are working to the pace of our teachers to ensure these programmes are well implemented next year. Attendance will be the focus right at the start of 2025. We need your support in ensuring your children are at school every day, for them to grasp onto new knowledge every day.

### Out of zone families

This is only a friendly reminder for all our families in our community. You cannot request for your child/ren to be in the mainstream if you are out-of-zone. It is illegal if you are using any family address around Sutton Park School to enrol your child/ren if you do not stay at that place. It is a serious offence to falsify your address.
