Attendance 2025

The Government's target is for 80% of students to attend regularly, that is to attend school more than 90% of the time. If I analyse the attendance data from last year this is how we were tracking.

Term 1 - 51% over 90% attendance

Term 2 - 50% over 90% attendance

Term 3 - 41% over 90% attendance

Term 4 - 39% over 90% attendance

These are low percentages of students attending school 90% and we have to get these numbers up. The majority of our children are attending 80% of the time so it is the matter of working together to get most of our children in the 90% range to boost our attendance.

Our teachers and our administration ladies are working hard in contacting parents and sometimes there is no response. An important note to parents - if you have changed phone numbers, address or email address please contact the school so we have your correct contact details. I know as a Principal that we can do better in our attendance through good communication.
